CARE OF CORIAN® SINKS AND WASHBASINS

- Corian® sinks and washbasins are hard wearing and durable but in order to maintain that “just fitted” appearance, they require regular attention and cleaning.
- As Corian® is a non-porous material, liquids such as tea and coffee will not stain, but if left they can dry on the surface and leave the Corian® looking dirty.
- Timely cleaning using non abrasive pads and warm soapy water can prevent dirty marks from forming.
- At least once a month, you should fill the sink or basin to a depth of approx 50mm and add approximately 3% household bleach to the water, leaving to soak for 12 hours.

- **Never** pour boiling water directly into a Corian® sink or basin. Always put some cold water in before adding boiling water.
